I am Oksana Dovganych, an abstract painter who works with graphics and oil painting. I graduated from the Transcarpathian Art Institute in Ungvár. My works often focus on landscapes. My emotionally expressive pictures convey thoughts and feelings. I like to transform and improve visual images, to create perceptions that immerse viewers in contexts beyond non-verbal and visual boundaries. Now I am restoring frescoes (wall paintings) in Ukrainian churches. My works are kept in private collections in Germany, Slovakia, Hungary and America. It is very difficult and often hopeless in Ukraine. But there are always people who try to give real and tangible help. This is László Őry, president of the Carpathian Art and Culture Association. He has been volunteering for Ukrainian art for 15 years. It is in a special situation because the Carpathian Art and Culture Association operates on the Ukrainian-Hungarian side, and it works well. This is why he received recognition from Ukraine's leading man in the fine arts - Andrey Chebikin - this summer. Since the outbreak of the war, he has been helping people and, of course, artists in Transcarpathia-Ukraine. This is very important because art is a very important expressive force of freedom and peace. There are a lot of refugees here in Transcarpathia. There are a lot of children. In my village (Zolotarevo) I hold an art session for them, which is very good therapy, but without the support of people like László Őry, this cannot be realized. Please, with great respect, please support the Carpathian Art and Culture Association so that they can help us in the difficult winter months that await us!!!
